Some 3,500 people were housed in our four lodging centers, for a total of almost 22,500 overnight stays.

More than 6,600 participations in our physical wellness programs (massage therapy and kinesiology) as well as our psychological support services (art therapy and telephone peer matching).





Your Gifts Mean Practical Help





You offer listening and counselling

\$20 allows 2 people with cancer to participate in an art therapy workshop.

You promote wellness

\$50 allows 5 people with cancer to participate in an adapted physical activity course led by a kinesiologist.





You reduce stress and anxiety

\$100 allows 4 people with cancer to receive a massage during their chemotherapy treatment.

You offer hospitality

\$250 contributes to the cost of lodging 1 person with cancer during their treatment week at a nearby cancer center (including meals, transportation and activities).

I am convinced that some who live farthest away from a hospital would be deprived of the health care they need for their recovery if they could not benefit from the Foundation's services.



Accommodation Centers

An island of peace in a sea of turmoil

Thanks to our four lodging centers located in Montreal (49 beds), Sherbrooke (30 beds), Trois-Rivières (24 beds) and Gatineau (26 beds), people who live far away from treatment centers can now be lodged at low cost, and focus on their healing.



"In the time I spent at the lodging center, knowing that I did not have to worry about the host of routine daily tasks (a rarity in the life of a mother of three boys!) I was able to concentrate on my inmost needs.

At 37 years of age, I decided to turn this obstacle in my life into a springboard to renewal.

And I made myself a promise: from that moment on, I would stop trying to please everyone and give myself the right to be me.

An accessible source of information

The Info-Cancer team of nurses and documentalists works in tandem with the health network. They respond to the questions and apprehensions of people with cancer and their families, and guide them toward appropriate resources and suggest relevant up-to-date literature.

For help over the phone

Nurses experienced in oncology:

- answer all your questions about the disease, treatments and ways to feel better;
- help prepare you for your meetings with the healthcare team;
- direct you to appropriate resources based on identified needs.

The Foundation has a wealth of information resources on a variety of cancer-related topics. These are available on loan free of charge, online or by phone, from anywhere in Quebec.

Documentalists experienced in oncology:

- direct you to reliable sites and suggest relevant, up-todate reading;
- help you to locate available resources in the various regions.

Psychological Support

Listening, comfort and guidance

The announcement of a cancer diagnosis overturns lives, triggers a host of emotions and raises multiple questions. This is why the Foundation provides free services to alleviate the psychological burden of the disease.

Telephone peer matching

People with cancer and their families can talk freely with someone who has experienced cancer and has been through similar trials. They can also seek professional help on a range of topics.

Art therapy

Creativity can unleash a range of emotions and offer an escape from preoccupations.

Our art therapists are professionals with training in art therapy, which incorporates both artistic and psychological practices.

Activities and support groups

A host of activities and support groups on various topics are offered to anyone seeking support and comfort.

Lighten the daily burden

The Foundation offers free or low-cost physical wellness programs that are recognized by the medical community.

Massage Therapy

The treatments given by our expert massage therapists specialized in masso-oncology produce enormous benefits by reducing stress, pain, and by promoting well-being and quality of sleep. Our massage therapists are accredited by the Fédération québécoise des massothérapeutes.

Kinesiology

The benefits of exercise are many: increased energy, lessened side effects of treatments, better stress and anxiety management, etc. Our kinesiologists offer customized programs tailored to each individual's physical condition.

Programme à Félix

"Don't just talk: take concrete action to make a difference in the lives of young people with cancer," declared Félix Deslauriers-Hallée, who died at the age of 20. His parents vowed to respect his wishes and joined the Quebec Cancer Foundation.



The Programme à Félix was created to provide cancer sufferers 15-39 years of age and their loved ones with everything they need to help them through this difficult time. The information it provides is adapted to this particular clientele, and covers a range of topics such as fertility, pregnancy, and insurance.

The program provides adolescents and young adults with services tailored to their specific needs, allowing them to be supported and served as comprehensively as other age groups.



New portal dedicated to young people with cancer and their loved ones

Since 2016, the www.cancer15-39.com portal has been providing, in clear, accessible language, relevant information on cancer to adolescents and young adults and on the range of services and resources available to them across the province. It offers tools and tips focused on the realities and needs of 15-39-year-olds with cancer and their families in order to support them every day. The portal also aims at raising awareness of the fact that cancer also strikes adolescents and young adults.



Chambre à Félix

The portal is an addition to the room at the Sherbrooke lodging centre that has been specially equipped to meet the needs of 15-39-year-olds.

The Chambre à Félix allows patients 15-39 years of age, accompanied by a relative, to stay close to the hospital at the time of a treatment or a medical appointment. The room has a warm, reassuring, comfortable and bright atmosphere, conducive to intimacy, well-being and calm. You will feel much more at home there than in the hospital.



Hope-raising Events

The Quebec Cancer Foundation organizes all kinds of activities across the province in support of people with cancer and their loved ones. Year after year, many artists, personalities, ambassadors, sponsors and participants get involved in these activities, ensuring renewed success time after time!

CANCERTO

Presented in a variety of formats, Cancerto is conceived as a celebration of life through a blend of spectacle, magical moments and unique meetings that pay tribute to the courage of those affected by cancer. In 2016, the Quebec Cancer Foundation once again presented the Cancerto series in Sherbrooke, Trois-Rivières, Gatineau, Quebec City and Montreal. Some 2,000 people attended the event, helping to raise over \$356,000!

COMPOSTELLE EN TANDEM

From September 10 to 23, 2016, fifteen Quebecers took up the Compostela en tandem challenge. In this 7th edition, they walked between 100 and 200 km along the legendary path. Their solidarity and perseverance enabled them to raise over \$40,000 to ensure that the thousands of Quebecers affected by cancer every year receive the support they need.

SOMETHING NEW FOR 2016!

The first edition of the *Rendez-vous Gentleman* was held in the fall and was declared a notable success. Over 450 "gentlemen" accompanied by a number of "ladies" had fun while doing good on the AML cruise ship Louis Jolliet. The various activities organized on the boat, combined with ticket sales, brought in a total of more than \$63,000!



The Grand défoulement contre le cancer

The Grand défoulement contre le cancer, a unique fund-raising event that took place from June 1 to 30, 2016, rallied many people to the cause, encouraging them to express themselves about cancer by getting them to organize or participate in an event or make a donation. This year's Grand défoulement instigated a wave of human solidarity across the province, raising nearly \$230,000 (\$90,000 more than in 2015), in aid of people with cancer and their families.
