40 YEARS OF SUPPORT

2019 marked our 40th anniversary. For four decades, the Quebec Cancer Foundation has been reaching out all across the province, providing support to people with cancer and their loved ones.

Since its creation, the Foundation has been fuelled by the passion, talent and dedication of extraordinary people. From its five founding fathers to the donors, partners, employees and volunteers of today, every one of these people has helped forge its deeply human, visionary character. They have contributed to its longevity and made the organization a true institution, with deep roots in the community through its six facilities, including the new Lévis Lodge that opened in the spring of 2020.

In the words of Manon Massé, who paid tribute to our 40th anniversary at the Quebec National Assembly on November 5, 2019: “On behalf of the people of Quebec and the half million Quebecers it has supported on a daily basis, I would like to take advantage of this anniversary to thank the directors, employees and hundreds of volunteers who have succeeded one another over the past 40 years. In all that time, these guardian angels have shown compassion and an inexhaustible generosity of heart.”

But the Quebec Cancer Foundation won't stop there: it has decided to be even CLOSER TO THE PEOPLE by going wherever anyone facing cancer is to be found, in every part of Quebec, and by developing new services that correspond to people's actual needs, regardless of their age or history:

- New free transportation corridors for patients at Laval's Cité-de-la-Santé Hospital and Charles-Le Moyne Hospital in Longueuil.
- Art therapy at the CHUM and Maisonneuve-Rosemont Hospital.
- New *marches du Grand dévouement* in Rimouski and Laval.
- Yoga in Chibougamau, Boucherville and the CHUM.
- In-chair massage therapy during chemotherapy treatments in 17 hospitals over a large territory from Montreal to Quebec City, including Granby, Cowansville, Saint-Hyacinthe, Drummondville, Fleurimont, Victoriaville, Sorel, Trois-Rivières, Shawinigan and Lévis.

Due to the loyalty of the entire family of the Quebec Cancer Foundation, we are able to faithfully support each and every person suffering from cancer and their loved ones, and to accompany them through the ordeal they are facing—not only today, but also tomorrow, by looking toward the future and maintaining our growth, always with an eye to their best interests.

Indeed, the impact of your donations continues far beyond that gesture. As you read on, you will discover some of the lives that have been transformed thanks to your generosity.



ONCE UPON A TIME, 40 YEARS AGO, FIVE DOCTORS

In 1979, outraged by the deplorable living conditions of some cancer patients located outside the major centres, five oncologists at Notre-Dame Hospital decided to tackle the problem themselves: **Dr. Michel Gélinas, Dr. Pierre Audet-Lapointe, Dr. Yvan Méthot, Dr. Maurice Falardeau and Dr. Pierre Band.**

They established the Quebec Cancer Foundation, an independent organization dedicated to improving patients' quality of life by providing access to information, psychological support and specialized accommodation within easy reach of the health care centres.

That was where our story began... And since that day, we have assisted over half a million Quebecers.

Half a million people who have benefited from our services in one way or another: a comfortable bed in one of our Regional Centres, a comforting response from an experienced oncology nurse via our Info-cancer Services, a moment of relaxation provided by our massage therapists who are specialized in masso-oncology and certified by the Fédération québécoise des massothérapeutes, a liberating brush stroke during an art therapy workshop, an illuminating bibliographical reference... Whatever their reason for coming to the Foundation, we have been there to help them through their ordeal.

The dream became a reality when those specialist physicians were no longer content to simply treat their patients, but actually transformed the ways things were done in their field.



ACCOMMODATE

Because a welcoming environment can break the isolation


The Quebec Cancer Foundation is the foremost organization that offers accommodation to people with cancer during their treatment, and also to their loved ones. Despite being away from their family, friends and their homes, our residents can profit from a warm, positive, reassuring living space in our four Lodges. They receive support and comfort at minimal cost as they are lodged, fed and accompanied on a daily basis by attentive employees and volunteers.

A bit of history...

Oncology treatments are spread over several weeks. Since these treatments are only available in large urban centres, people from remote areas used to have to find a place to stay at their own expense, which only aggravated their anxiety and fatigue. As a radiation oncologist, I was very concerned about this situation. Forty years ago, no other organization took this aspect of patient care seriously. The situation was often deplorable.

Because sharing brings comfort

It's reassuring to be able to count on attentive people who are ready to answer questions and calm anxieties. The telephone peer matching service, complementary therapies and social activities provide sources of strength, energy and relaxation for people with cancer and their loved ones, making their experience with the disease less painful. These activities are offered free of charge or at low cost in every Regional Centre in Quebec.

"The Foundation's massage therapists make us feel like people, not patients. They manage to instill confidence in us even before they start. The first massage we receive is from their smile. Sure, there's the science. Surgery, radiation, chemotherapy... treatments for the body. But you also need healing for the heart and soul. And that's why the Quebec Cancer Foundation offers us these moments of tenderness."

These methods are effective in releasing the stress and tension associated with the disease. They make it easier for patients to express their emotions and encourage them to focus their energy on healing rather than brooding.

INFORM

Because knowledge is reassuring

Faced with the uncertainty and fear of a cancer diagnosis, it's essential to be informed. From its Regional Centre in Quebec City, the Foundation plays a central role in disseminating information about cancer. Through its Info-cancer Services and its Documentation Centre, it offers support to people living with cancer, their loved ones, the general public and healthcare professionals.

"My contact with the Info-cancer Services was very sympathetic. An experienced person sent me documents about my cancer and also put me in contact with someone who had been diagnosed with the same condition as me. Whenever they received any new documents that related to my request, they would send them to me. They were still thinking about me! It's so reassuring, especially in difficult moments. I felt a presence, a collaboration, and above all, I felt that those people were putting their whole hearts into it."

In those days, the majority of the population knew nothing about cancer and what forms of treatment were available. The most common treatment was surgery; radiotherapy and chemotherapy were still new, troublesome approaches... Quebecers wanted to better understand the disease and its impacts. Our first line of attack was to give them adequate information in the form of our information brochures.

At the other end of the line is a nurse experienced in oncology who, in total confidentiality, is available to listen to you and offer information about every aspect of cancer.

She can also refer you to a free consultation service with our nutritionist and psychologist.

Info-cancer Library

The Info-cancer Library, the only specialized French-language library of its kind in North America, contains a vast collection of works on every aspect of cancer and on ways to live better with the disease: the various types of cancer and their symptoms, treatments and side effects, support, complementary medicine, nutrition, etc.



LA MARCHÉ DU GRAND DÉFOULEMENT ▶



This year, in addition to the six existing walks in **Quebec City, Montreal, Rouyn-Noranda, Trois-Rivières, Gatineau and Granby**, two new walks were added in Laval in partnership with the Maxime-Letendre Foundation and in Rimouski in partnership with the Association du cancer de l'Est du Québec.

More than **1,200 people marched alongside the Foundation** to proclaim their support for people dealing with cancer. The program for these eight beautiful days included games, music, speeches, massages and murals. And of course, eight walks brimming with hope and the joy of living. Families, colleagues and friends joined forces to raise funds and support these Quebecers facing cancer.

The walks were attended by Quebec personalities such as race car drivers Jean-François and Louis-Philippe Dumoulin, host and actor Luc Senay, and the mayor of Laval, Marc Demers, who were the Foundation's ambassadors in Mauricie, Eastern Townships, and Laval respectively. The marchers were inspired by the magical, touching atmosphere, full of dynamic, soulful energy. They will no doubt always treasure indelible memories of their experience. The granddaughter of a member of the organizing committee of the Quebec City walk fell under the

spell and exclaimed that she wanted to volunteer for the Foundation. "This is the best party of my life," she said—she was just 8 years old.

At the Granby walk the Beaulieu clan came to support Marie-Claude Beaulieu, whose breast cancer is going into remission. "A walk like this one tonight is one of the few things that you can do as a group, that you can share, when you have cancer. Even though you have people around you, you're often alone with your illness, especially after the treatments," Marie-Claude Beaulieu said.

With more than \$240,000 raised—over 20% more than last year—the Quebec Cancer Foundation will be able to support more people, come to their aid more swiftly, and accompany them more effectively.

The Quebec Cancer Foundation would like to extend its warmest thanks to all participants, donors, volunteers and partners for this great moment of sharing and solidarity.



They're walkers but they're also philanthropists. They chose to take up the *Chemin des Sanctuaires* Challenge, the Magdalen Islands Challenge or the *Compostelle en tandem* Challenge in order to surpass themselves and at the same time collect donations to help people facing cancer.



When I told my children that I was up for the challenge, I saw their faces beaming with pride. The *Chemin des Sanctuaires* Challenge seemed like a gift I was able to offer myself, after having had to deal with the disease on two occasions in the last few years, one right after the other: first it was my spouse, who had Alzheimer's, and then it was my own diagnosis with cancer.

The entire trip was punctuated with a thousand pleasures. I was the oldest of the 14 people in our group. The youngest was 20. I brought up the rear, but everyone took turns walking along with

me. It made my heart sing.

It was a pilgrimage of life that took me through villages that had special meaning for me and to Saint-Roch, the parish where I grew up, culminating with a visit to the little chapel of Sainte-Anne. My family and friends were all waiting for me when I arrived. I was so moved, grateful, and proud to have succeeded...


