A stronger ecosystem in support of the quality of life of people affected by cancer

In an environment marked by an increasingly fragile healthcare system and an aging population, the Foundation's commitment to strengthening the current ecosystem as a means of improving the quality of life of people with cancer manifested itself in 2023 by concrete actions, positive impacts and inspiring success stories.

This past year brought daring leadership, enlightening partnerships and strategic reinforcements to the Quebec Cancer Foundation, enabling us to meet the growing needs of patients navigating the healthcare system's myriad issues. Patients are currently experiencing delays at every step of their intake, and this is while their physical, emotional and economic problems continue to multiply. This reality prompted us to change our approach to better adapt to a healthcare environment that is in constant transformation and to intensify our efforts to improve the quality of life and the health of people impacted by cancer in Quebec.

We reached a new level concerning the use of our **accommodations located near cancer centers, with close to 35,000 nights (representing a 17% increase)** spent in our six Lodges. Our first Lodges were given a new lease on life, and others will soon be revamped from top to bottom, to provide a safe and comforting space for those who need it the most.

Our Support program for daily living activities (PAVQ), in turn, granted over \$130,000 to help lighten the load for 374 Quebec families impacted by cancer and in a precarious situation. We also trained 139 healthcare professionals, including social workers, in the oncology department of hospitals across Quebec, to help patients with their application to the program. In addition, our partnership with Juripop enabled us to offer legal assistance to 51 individuals.

By further reinforcing our strategic commitment to the healthcare system, we are essentially supporting the activities of front-line support staff and by extension, improving the well-being of people with cancer and their loved ones. Our impact was also reflected by the **over 17,000 participations in our complementary therapy sessions** over the year, a 21% increase over the previous period. The roll-out of our 2024-2026 strategic plan coincides with a new era for the Quebec oncology ecosystem, one in which we are uniquely positioned to maximize the impact of our activities on patients and their loved ones.

At the Foundation, we favour a resilient healthcare system able to provide communities with access to necessary services. At least one of our complementary therapy services (and sometimes more) is offered in **close to 30 institutions** in Quebec (including Îles-de-la-Madeleine and the Beauce, Saguenay and Abitibi-Témiscamingue regions). We have also recently struck **9 new partnerships** across the province.

We collaborate with these partners to strengthen the local health infrastructure and make communities increasingly aware of the importance of prevention. By investing in developing such partnerships, we are helping create environments that foster the population's well-being.

In addition, our Info-cancer Services, which include the Info-cancer Hotline, access to nurses, nutritionists, psychologists, documentalists and a sexologist experienced in the field of oncology, along with a telephone peer matching service, are powerful beacons of assistance and support that are more in demand than ever before, and this by people with cancer as well as their loved ones. **Our Info-cancer Library**, a valuable resource, was visited by over 36,000 people over the past year.

We are extremely grateful for the support of the Quebec business community and its significant contribution to our critical mission. This community notably shone by its rousing involvement in our corporate campaign, including the series of Cancerto benefit evenings. These evenings notably resulted in **over \$1,507,000 being raised** on behalf of the Foundation and its beneficiaries.

Each of our supporters is a source of inspiration that enables us to keep moving forward. In 2023, the vast family that makes up the Quebec Cancer Foundation made it possible for us to raise over \$8.7 million. We are more determined than ever to continue positively impacting the lives of Quebecers affected by cancer, and your donations have an impact that goes far beyond the immediate moment.

Our vision is clear: to facilitate access to front-line oncology services for all Quebecers with cancer and their loved ones. How? In several ways, but particularly by providing **financial assistance totalling \$1 million to cancer center initiatives**. This would not even be conceivable without your stalwart support.

We also want to reiterate our gratitude to the members of the Board of Directors for their support and trust over the past year, as well as to the numerous Foundation team members and volunteers. Together, we are doing much more than simply making a difference: we are building a movement based on hope and solidarity, where every single gesture counts.


A key partner in the area of oncology: a commitment to Quebecers and the healthcare network



In December 2023, the Quebec Cancer Foundation's Board of Directors and its General Manager Marco Décelles eagerly approved the organization's 2024-2026 strategic plan. Dubbed **"Facilitating access to front-line oncology services throughout Quebec"**, this powerful plan is the result of an extensive consultation process involving members of the Board of Directors, Foundation managers and employees, and numerous partners and collaborators. It reasserted the relevance and significance of our role as a front-line player and key partner in the field of oncology.

The plan puts forth concrete measures to extend the scope of our actions and amplify the impact we can have on cancer and the daily benefits we can bring to Quebecers facing the disease. It also constitutes a proactive response to the healthcare system's ailments, and this is in a context where every 8 minutes, a Quebecer receives a cancer diagnosis, this disease being the primary cause of death in the province.

Three major development areas of focus are addressed in this three-year plan:

Alongside the disease stands life!

You most likely saw the heart-wrenching television ad I participated in on behalf of the Quebec Cancer Foundation; it was a poignant reminder that in spite of the turmoil of a cancer diagnosis, life goes on, with all of its challenges and beauty.

Because after the initial shock of receiving the dreaded diagnosis, the 67,500 people impacted each year must continue to cope with the daily grind. Throughout this journey, loved ones strive to offer what help and support they can, in whatever manner available to them. Like those loved ones, the Quebec Cancer Foundation seeks to care for and support the human being, the person who must battle with all that they have while others treat the disease.

The Foundation reaches out to help people facing cancer find their balance and tackle each obstacle, one step at a time. Whether it consists of answering an endless string of questions, lending a compassionate ear or helping to assuage physical, financial or logistical concerns, the Foundation is there. Through every one of our actions, we focus on celebrating life, even at the most difficult of times.

As the Foundation's spokesperson, I am immensely proud to contribute to such a noble cause. Each diagnosis represents an individual tragedy, but also an opportunity to collectively take action, support and help.

In February 2023, after having spent several months trying to figure out what ailed me (during which time I received an erroneous diagnosis), I learned that I had anal cancer.

Being self-employed, this diagnosis had a shattering impact on my professional activities; I had to significantly cut back on my working hours, which led to a significant drop in income. Imagine going from a situation of financial stability to a world of uncertainty in one fell swoop... while undergoing chemotherapy and radiation therapy... that was me, one year ago.

This financial pressure exacerbated the already difficult burden of my illness and represented an additional stress that I could have done without. Receiving a cancer diagnosis has an impact on our daily activities, which in turn affects our finances, as the bills and other expenses continue to pile up.

Luckily, my social worker spoke to me about the PAVQ, the Quebec Cancer Foundation's Support program for daily living activities, and suggested that I submit a request. I cannot emphasize how important this was, particularly when we consider that being struck with cancer is definitely challenging.

I understand that the Support program for daily living activities will not solve my financial situation, but it is nonetheless a valuable source of support. This support is all the more welcome given that available financial resources (government or community) for people in my shoes are truly scarce. This dearth of help often triggers human tragedies. Our government has got significant work to do in this regard.

When left to face a healthcare system that is floundering and barely humane or kind, it is greatly reassuring to know that some people and organizations step up to help those with cancer. The Quebec Cancer Foundation meets this essential need by facilitating access to its interprofessional oncology team and its various services in the areas of support, accommodations and companionship for patients, loved ones and health professionals. All of this makes a real difference in our lives!

In a warm and welcoming setting reserved for women, the participants enjoyed a gourmet meal while listening to a musical performance by Marie-Élaine Thibert.

A total of \$181,143 was raised during this second edition of the evening, held in conjunction with the Foundation. This amount will be dedicated to maintaining and improving the Saint-Hyacinthe service center activities.



Expanding our impact: key partnerships for the well-being of people with cancer

Our commitment to the overall well-being of people affected by cancer led us to develop important partnerships at both provincial and national levels. In 2023, we strengthened our alliances with major actors such as the CISSS Montérégie-Centre, the CISSS Montérégie-Est, the CIUSSS de l'Est de Montréal, the CISSS du Nord de l'Île and several other organizations, all to provide yet more support.

We are especially proud of our recent cooperation with **Se reconstruire – Centre de santé du sein**. This partnership offers women with breast cancer the possibility of receiving a free 3D tattoo, as part of a community initiative shown to promote greater self-confidence.

In addition, our partnership with the **Canadian Cancer Survivor Network** has enabled us to meet the needs of a growing number of people impacted by the disease. Thanks to this collaboration, we were able to expand the scope of our impact and thereby provide greater access to information, support and assistance from experienced oncology professionals through our Info-cancer Hotline.

Finally, our cooperation with **Kidney Cancer Canada** seeks to enhance the community services provided and thereby improve quality of life, particularly through complementary therapies.

These partnerships, in tandem with the ongoing efforts of various organizations in this field, are essential to drive our mission of supporting and helping patients with cancer and their loved ones.

Corporate campaign and Cancerto 2023

This evening alone allowed for gathering \$291,000.

La marche du Grand défoulement 2023

The 6th edition of *La marche du Grand défoulement*, presented by Desjardins in collaboration with Larivière et Massicotte, Pharmaciennes Inc. – Pharmacie d'expertise, **allowed for raising the impressive sum of \$458,000**.

Between September 9 and 23, from Montreal to Granby, and in cities such as Trois-Rivières, Quebec and Gatineau, a total of 1,150 participants – grouped in 144 teams – walked to celebrate the courage and rally in support of Quebecers currently affected by cancer.

THE FOUNDATION: A BENEVOLENT GIFT

Cancer upends so many lives, arriving on the doorstep of people without any discrimination. Successful businesswoman and entrepreneur Sophie Reis knows a thing or two about the disease, having been diagnosed with breast cancer in December 2020, when she was 38 years old.

Blown away by the news, for she had no symptoms and no family history of the disease, Sophie was welcomed by the Foundation, whose staff members and partners helped her discover various complementary therapies such as acupuncture, kinesiology and art therapy. This early support helped her navigate the journey with more joy, peace and vitality. In February 2023, she published the novel *Un cancer en cadeau*, in which she shares details of her experience and how she became resilient through action.

Sophie agreed, with great honour, to serve as the provincial ambassador of the 6th edition of *La marche du Grand défoulement*.

"Cancer is not a gift for anyone. Yet, the personal journey it entails allows you to meet special people from whom you learn things that in retrospect, can truly be considered as gifts. One of these encounters was with the Quebec Cancer Foundation, which played a tremendous role in my cancer journey. The Foundation lives this notion in all that it does, which is why I see getting involved as truly important."


