It's a known fact that true leaders are those who transform their words into action. Who listen more often than they speak. Who foster a collaborative approach where everyone's unique skills are put to good use in pursuit of a common goal. The Foundation's objective of bolstering the Quebec healthcare system to improve the journey of people with cancer is arguably ambitious. Yet, the sheer magnitude of the task has not prevented us from ensuring that our actions speak for themselves by focusing on our new strategic orientations, which are resolutely concrete and human-centered.

A change agent in the healthcare system

On February 1, 2024, in tandem with World Cancer Day, we launched our annual awareness campaign at the National Assembly, seizing the opportunity to rally and drive home—on bus shelters and road signs, as well as through digital media—a disturbing fact: every 8 minutes, someone in Quebec is diagnosed with cancer. And the statistics in this regard are becoming increasingly alarming. Dr. Philippe Sauthier, Chair of the Quebec Cancer Foundation's Board of Directors, explained: **"This urgent need to act is what drove us to bring our message to the attention of elected officials, asking them to establish a clear action plan for cancer, with specific indicators and dedicated funding. The general public was also invited to sign an online manifesto asking that cancer be flagged as a priority issue for the Quebec healthcare system."** Across all channels, our pleas and awareness initiatives reached millions, raising awareness of our cause and providing valuable information about the Foundation's services. These efforts also strengthened our presence and ensured our voice was heard in the public arena.

A unifying role in the ecosystem

True to our approach, which consists of not only talking but doing, and because cancer waits for no one, in February 2024, we pledged to raise a total of \$8.5 million — a goal we not only reached but surpassed later that year. **"True leadership is also about prioritizing cooperation over individual impact, allowing us to amplify our collective influence on policies that support our beneficiaries, particularly the province's plan to fight cancer,"** stated Marco Décelles, General Manager of the Quebec Cancer Foundation. **"Cancer doesn't wait: the future Health Quebec Agency must act!"** is a brief (in French only) prepared by the Quebec Cancer Foundation, the Cancer Research Society, Leucan, and Procure. While working on this initiative, we combined our expertise and hands-on knowledge to draft concrete recommendations that were then submitted to the government in support of a proactive approach based on the needs of both communities and patients.

We are of the humble opinion that our 45 years of activity have imbued us with a wisdom of sorts, readying us to face the challenges of today with an unwavering will. To kick off this special year, we announced the roll-out of two new programs. First, we introduced the **Oncology financial support program, endowed with funding of \$1M over four years**. This amount will enable us to support hospital center projects aimed at better supporting people with cancer across Quebec, improving their healthcare journey, and enhancing oncology services. Additionally, we launched an improved version of our **Corporate support program**, with businesswoman Danièle Henkel as its patron. This initiative strives to provide effective tools for managing the professional repercussions of cancer, including personalized support and concrete interventions.

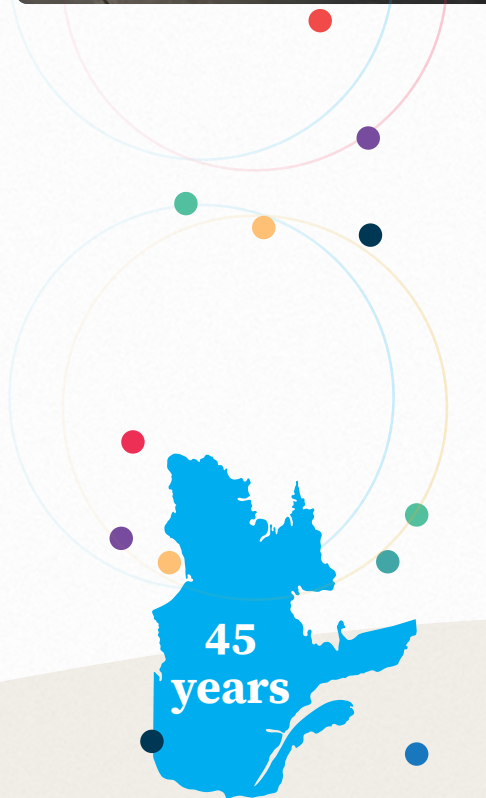
2024 was also marked by several new partnerships with different organizations and foundations, with a view to simplifying access to specific services for patients with certain needs. These organizations include **Ovarian Cancer Canada, Myeloma Canada, Leucan, and Fondation Charles-Bruneau**, with which we joined forces to carry out original projects. For example, **Clic santé** will now allow patients to schedule an appointment with an Info-cancer Hotline nurse. This initiative allows us to expand our reach and help yet more people throughout the province.

Facilitating access to services for people with cancer

We are truly proud of the ongoing evolution of our services. In 2024, for example, we announced the opening of a **seventh Lodge in Rouyn-Noranda in 2025**, to support one of our core services: providing accommodations to people undergoing cancer treatment. This news was particularly exciting and symbolic, as it highlights the fact that we have built the largest accommodations network of its kind in the province. This new facility will allow us to further expand our presence in Quebec and strengthen ties with underserved communities. In 2024 alone, our Lodges represented a total of 33,000 nights for people in need. Our other services also kept growing, as attested by the over 20,000 instances of participation in complementary therapies—an increase of nearly 18% compared to 2023. In another sphere, **over \$245,000 was granted through the Support program for daily living activities**.

Lastly, we wrapped up 2024 with a **novel prevention-focused initiative in 185 clinics in Quebec**, seeking to raise awareness among thousands of patients about the importance of screening tests. And this is but the beginning.

“Whether we are patients, doctors, case workers, volunteers, donors, organizations, media representatives, members of the business community, or elected officials, we can all do our part to address the challenges in the area of oncology in Quebec. Thank you, not only for being a source of inspiration, but for enabling our collective action and leadership concerning this vital issue,” declared Dr. Philippe Sauthier.

Last September, we celebrated our 45th anniversary, a milestone that gave us the perfect opportunity to measure our progress over time, the impact of our actions, and the scope of our achievements. As we did so, one feeling stood out above all others: **pride**.

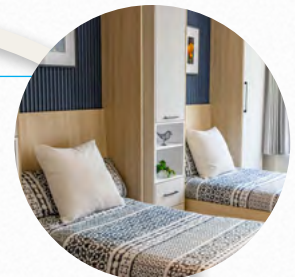

Lightening the burden of the “Wheel of misfortune”

If you're like me, you were surely shaken by the most recent Quebec Cancer Foundation ads featuring a game no one wants to win.

With its “Wheel of **mis**fortune”, the Foundation made people sit up and take notice by being among the first to dare to bring up the costs of battling cancer in Quebec. And I intentionally spoke of costs rather than cost (in a singular form), as there are many. There is the psychological cost, ensuing from the shock and anxiety that accompany a cancer diagnosis. There is also a physical cost, including fatigue, side effects of the treatment, and the disease's impact itself. We must also add the toll cancer takes on one's family, social activities, and professional life... And then, the oftentimes overwhelming financial expenses: loss of income, travel expenses, the costs of treatment and medications, and so much more. Moreover, these costs must be borne while having to cope with the disease, which amounts to a burden that is often unbearable.

The reason I am so aware of the costs? Because my family is currently at my brother's side as he fights the disease. Seeing the impacts every day, we quickly understood that cancer never touches just one person but also loved ones and caregivers.

This is why I'm so determined to support the Quebec Cancer Foundation. Thanks to its information and accommodation services, psychological support, and financial assistance, the Foundation helps lighten the load for thousands of Quebecers with cancer. By offering these services, people can focus on what's most important: healing and cherishing life's precious moments.

Sadly, many hesitate to seek help. Unaware that these vital, confidential services are free, or believing cancer is their burden to bear alone. I'm speaking on behalf of the Foundation for all of these people. To make them aware of the Foundation's outstanding work. And to simply let them know that they are not alone.

Today, I'm proud to be part of a movement where people—like you—are committed to helping lighten the load of battling cancer. On behalf of the half a million people helped since 1979, thank you for your support!



From caregiver to beneficiary

Luce's story

Having spent 20 years working for the Quebec Cancer Foundation, I thought I knew everything about the organization. This was before I received a breast cancer diagnosis in 2021.

Of course, I was aware of the resources offered by the Foundation, and I could speak the "language of cancer". And I knew what my upcoming journey would hold.

And yet, all this knowledge doesn't make the process any easier when you're the one going through it...

During the initial months of testing, I told no one about what I was going through. I had the feeling I was still in control of my life. My reaction to the news surprised me, as it was the polar opposite of what we recommended that people do. A bit like the cobbler's children who go barefoot, isn't it?

The Info-cancer researchers and nurses were of great assistance, speaking with me and recommending some reading material. I also received kinesiology treatments, a service offered by the Foundation as a complementary therapy.

During my journey, I had to learn to let go. To accept that I was now the beneficiary.

During my treatments, I also discovered the power of acupuncture. The benefits I gained from this complementary therapy, including greater control over the side effects of hormonal therapy, led me to invite the professional acupuncturist trained in oncology who treated me to offer her services to the Foundation. A wonderful resource that, for the past year, has enriched the range of complementary therapies available to the residents of the Trois-Rivières Lodge.

The Foundation is working hard to build more partnerships of this type as a way of extending the reach of its services beyond its Regional Centers and Lodges. This will allow people with cancer to benefit from our support closer to their home, not just near their treatment center.

I dedicated a large part of my career to this cause, and am proud to be part of a movement celebrating the Foundation's 45th anniversary. But more importantly, I now truly understand how critical the organization's mission is.

Cooperate, innovate, optimize

Driven by our commitment to the well-being of people facing cancer and our dedication to strengthening the healthcare ecosystem, we established meaningful new partnerships to better support patients and their loved ones.

Thanks to the Foundation's inspiring collaboration with **Se reconstruire – Centre de santé du sein** and **Fondation Hôpital Pierre-Boucher**, people with breast cancer now have access to endermotherapy at a reduced cost. This treatment, which works deep within the tissues, helps relax the muscles, reduce inflammation, and accelerate the scarring process.

During Childhood Cancer Awareness Month, we were also proud to join forces with **Leucan** and **Fondation Charles-Bruneau** to develop a new financial assistance program for young people living with the long-term effects of cancer and its treatments. Thanks to this innovative partnership, we are now able to extend the storage period of reproductive cells by five additional years by covering the associated storage costs. This initiative is critical, as more than two-thirds of children treated for cancer experience serious long-term effects, including infertility.

This desire to collaborate, innovate, and optimize also led us to work closely with **Ovarian Cancer Canada**. This alliance allows people with ovarian cancer to be matched with peers who have gone through a similar ordeal, providing post-cancer support, addressing the challenges associated with rehabilitation, and promoting reintegration into work and social life, among other benefits.

Thanks to our unifying role and our support for the ongoing efforts of numerous local organizations, we have built invaluable partnerships that have expanded our impact on the well-being of Quebecers affected by cancer and their loved ones.

La marche du Grand défolement 2024

The 7th edition of *La marche du Grand défolement*, presented by Desjardins in collaboration with Larivière et Massicotte, Pharmaciennes Inc. – Pharmacie d'expertise, raised the impressive sum of \$462,500.

Between September 7 and 21, from Montreal to Granby, including cities such as Trois-Rivières, Quebec City, and Chelsea, a total of 1,400 participants—organized into 139 teams—walked to celebrate courage and show solidarity with Quebecers facing cancer.

In 2024, well-known host and reporter Sophie Durocher shared her personal experience with cancer.

Knowing that every act of solidarity makes a difference, she traded in her microphone for running shoes to serve as the provincial ambassador of the 7th edition of *La marche du Grand dévouement*.

She first got involved on behalf of her father, diagnosed with cancer in 2022, and later for her spouse, journalist Richard Martineau, who spoke publicly about his prostate cancer to raise awareness of the importance of regular screening tests.

“Several of my close friends have had to face cancer. Others lost their lives to the disease. But regardless of the outcome, no one should have to go through this ordeal alone. I’m committed to breaking the taboo around cancer and encouraging people to seek help. The Quebec Cancer Foundation has something to offer to everyone. Whether you want to express your emotions through art therapy, attend group yoga classes, or simply talk to someone who’s been through it too, the Foundation offers services to meet your needs! That’s why I find this organization so important.”

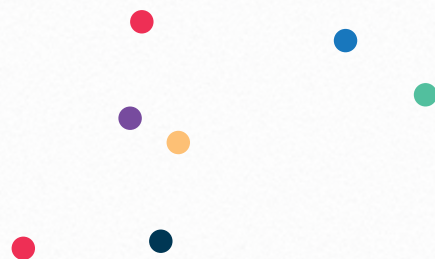

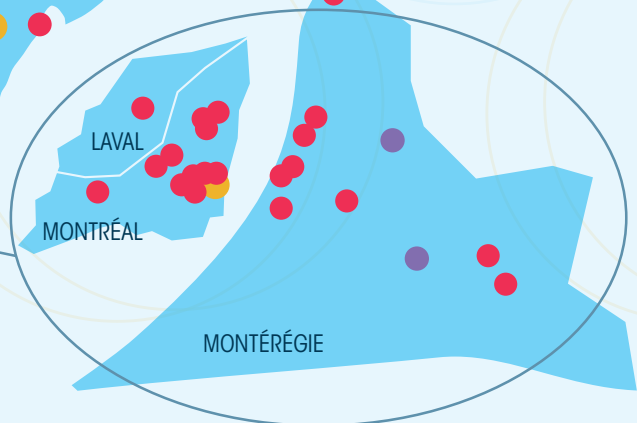
